## Project Overview:

## Portfolio Website

Over the next several weeks you will be developing a web portfolio to showcase some of your strongest design work. We are working within a very tight timeframe, so it is important to stay on top of deadlines and be organized.

#### First Steps:

- 1. Create a statement about yourself. This statement should explain your interest in the graphic arts and describe what are your main qualifications (strengths, skills, areas of expertise)?
- 2. Begin to collect and organize the projects you would like to showcase. Some of them might need to be revised and fine-tuned. You should aim to showcase 8-12 pieces in your portfolio.
- 3. Design a logo that represents you and your work. The logo should become part of your identity system, and be visible on your site.

#### Project Requirements:

The final project must have a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 6 sections. Site identifier (logo) and navigation must remain consistent throughout the entire site. (*Project dimensions will be specified as we approach the relevant stage.*)

**Section 1**: Intro/Welcoming page: The homepage should welcome a user and explain what the site is about.

#### Section 2: Biography/About/Resume/

#### Section 3: Portfolio

For each piece you will be showcasing your portfolio (8-12 pieces) you must include:

- 1. Project Title
- 2. Client Name/ Class Name
- 3. Goal of Project/ Assignment
- 4. Design Solution: Brief description of how the concept met the needs of the client/assignment
- 5. Applications used
- 6. Typefaces used
